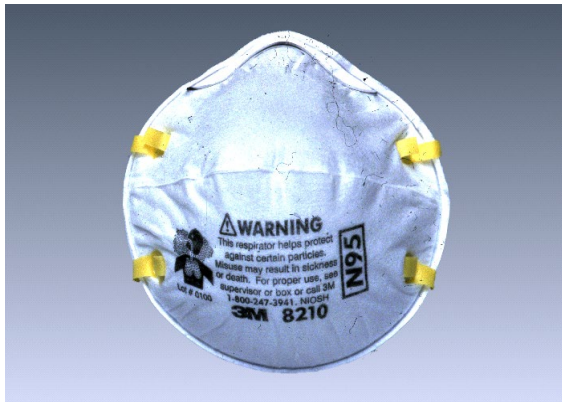


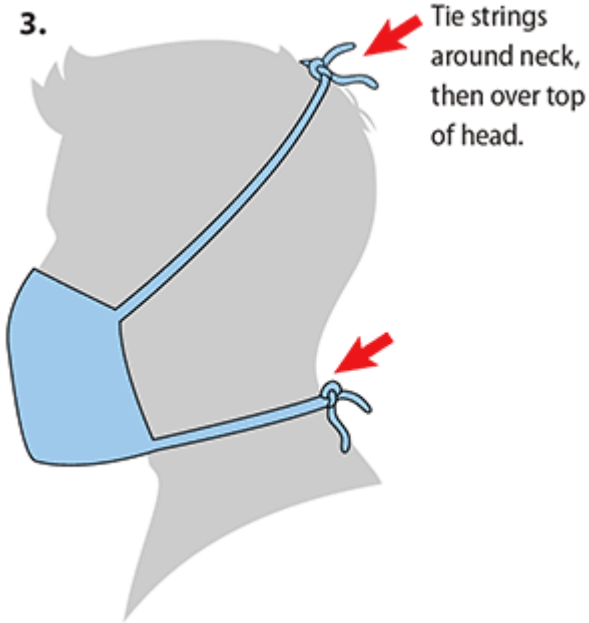
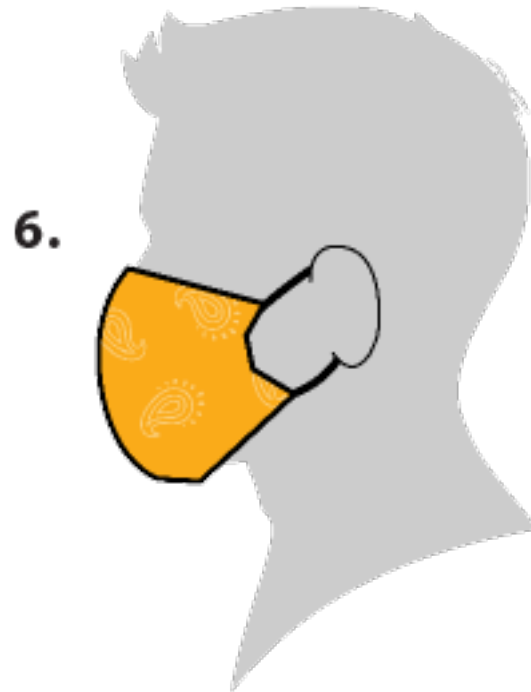

Injury and Illness Prevention Program (IIPP)

➤ Cal/OSHA section 3203: establish and implement a written, effective IIPP to protect employees from workplace hazards:

1. Authority and responsibility
2. System to ensure employee compliance
3. System for two-way communication
4. Procedures for identifying and evaluating hazards
5. Procedures to investigate injuries and illnesses
6. Procedures for correcting unsafe conditions (infection prevention measures)
7. Training and instruction
8. Allow employee access to the program
9. Recordkeeping
